- three international and domestic routes connecting Gdańsk, Warsaw, Rzeszów and Lublin




ECONOMIC POTENTIAL

The city has about 25,000 economic entities supported by a network of business assisting institutions.

Ranked as the second important education centre in the Mazovian Voivodship, Radom offers 50% lower costs of living than the capital city.









SELECTED EVENTS

- ► Certamen Compositorum Internationale.
 - **"Arboretum"** Krzysztof Penderecki International Composers" competition is participated by composers from around the world.
- ▶ International Gombrowicz Festival. Organized by Jan Kochanowski Theatre in Radom, it is one of the most important Polish theatre festivals, comprising theatre, science visual arts, music and film.





- ▶ International Jazz Festival. Cafe Jazz Festival Radom offers a vast repertoire of musical styles ranging from old good swing, jazz, dixieland, boogie-woogie, to gospel and blues.
- The cyclical nature of the event is guaranteed by the growing group of music admirers and recipients of the festival's program offer.
- Offering unusual performances by artists all over the world, International Festival of Street Artists and Precision is an interdisciplinary event that attracts crowds to the Radom promenade.





CULTURE

Exhibitions and performances (cultural centres: "Łaźnia" and "Resursa Obywatelska", Masovian Center of Contemporary Art "Elektrownia", Jacek Malczewski Museum) Radom boasts of one of the best collections of contemporary art in Poland, and one of the four biggest national collections of works by Jacek Malczewski.

- ▶ Outdoor events related to the history and traditions of the city include: Street of Tradition, Medieval Historical Picnic, Anima Urbis night tour of the city, battles reconstructions of the January Uprising and the Polish-Russian war.
- ► Concerts and music festivals The Mikołaj of Radom International Early Music Festival, Radom Jazz Festival, series of "Let us meet at Żeromskiego street".
- ► Events related with plants traditionally cultivated in the Radom region such as cereals (Bread Festival) and potatoes (Potatoes Feast).



- ▶ National Film Meetings "Intimate Summer" a project which is a combination of complex movie workshops for young people (theoretical lectures and practical training courses) with discussion panels, open film screenings, film competitions and innovative forms of public education.
- ▶ **Radom Fashion Show** is a national competition that supports young debutants. It is also a presentation of the latest fashion trends.



▶ June 1976 protests - the most important stop on the way to freedom in the 20th century are commemorated by musical performances with Polish artists, such as Radom June '76, Half Marathon, historical picnic and other. It is also a unique opportunity to meet the protest participants.
