



The rules for crediting foreign internships applicable to Faculty of Medical Sciences and Health Sciences

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- 1. During the studies it is obligatory to complete the internships specified in the study program.
- 2. The student has the opportunity to undergo apprenticeships as part of a trip abroad covered by the Erasmus + program or other programs, organized by the IFMSA International Federation of Medical Students Association or other associations. The student also has the opportunity to independently organize an internship financed from his own funds.
- 3. A student expressing the will to do an internship abroad should report such information to the Directional Internship Tutor / Faculty Coordinator of the Erasmus + PROGRAM, not later than 90 days before the planned internship. The student submits an application to the Dean for consent to undergo an apprenticeship, attaching a document confirming the possibility of achieving the learning outcomes provided for in the apprenticeship program at the indicated institution (template to be downloaded from the Faculty's website) and a letter accepting admission to a foreign apprenticeship optional (issued by the host institution).
- 4. After obtaining the Dean's consent for an internship at the indicated institution, the student is obliged to download from the Faculty's website a template of the internship journal and complete it in the institution where he / she will be practicing.
- 5. The condition for obtaining a credit for completed internships is the presentation of a document confirming the number of hours of internships and the learning outcomes and obtained ECTS points (internship journal) assigned to a given internship. The student may additionally present the obtained certificate showing the number of hours completed, obtained ECTS points and internship grades (issued by the host institution).
- 6. Within two weeks of the end of the internship, the student is obliged to submit an application to the Dean of the Faculty with a request for credit. In addition, the documents indicated in point 5 must be attached to the application.





- 7. The decision on crediting the internship completed as part of a foreign trip is made by the Dean of the Faculty of Medical Sciences and Health Sciences.
- 8. The student has the opportunity to complete an additional internship abroad, not covered by the study program, as part of the Erasmus + program or other programs or organized by student associations, according to the rules covered by the program.
